## DIRECTIONS:

- Cut out the rhyming cards, answers page, and $X$ and $O$ cards from your workbook.
- Optional: Laminate them to play over and over again.
- Then create a pocket by gluing the sides and bottom of the answers page to the back of this page. You will use this to store your rhyming and $X \& O$ cards.
- Scan the $Q R$ code to play the Tic-Tac-Toe rhyming game with Miss Toni and Miss Megan.
- After the video, distribute the $x$ and $o$ cards to each player. Then place the rhyming cards upside down in a stack.
- To start, player number 1 will draw a rhyming card from the deck. They will say the word out loud, and then try to find its' matching picture on the Tic-Tac-Toe game board. Once they find their match, they will place their $X$ or $O$ card on top of that square.
- Player 2 will then take their turn.
- Continue to play until one player has 3 in a row or all squares are filled.
